

How to View Flash Video on iPad

Have you had difficulty viewing video on your iPad? Does an error message pop up when you try to download Flash Player? Apple iPad does not support Adobe Flash Player. HOWEVER, there is a way to view Flash Video on your iPad after all!

Go to the App Store and download an App called "Puffin"
The download is free with a 30 day trial, then it needs to be purchased for \$.99 cents!
Well worth the dollar in my experience.

Puffin is a web browser that has a similar interface to Windows 8 Home Screen. Once this is downloaded and you run across a video that requires Flash, simply touch the URL address for a second or two, until the selection comes up to "select all", which will highlight the address; then there will be a choice to "copy", which you will choose. Next, open Puffin, clear the URL address line, hold you finger on the space a second or two until you have the option to "paste", choose that, the address will then be in the URL address bar in Puffin, hit "enter" or "go", and like magic, your video will appear and begin to play! It works quickly and I have not had a problem with it.

If you know there are going to be videos that require Flash Player, such as in Facebook, use Puffin as your Web Browser when you log into Facebook. That will save you the selecting, copying and pasting the URL's.
